42.	<p><b>Councillor’s report</b> Parish Councillors raised concerns about the condition of the Marsh Gibbon Road towards the A41 and agreed to advise Cllr Sames of overgrown hedges in the area. The Parish Council confirmed that they had been very pleased at the prompt and efficient way CDC had dealt with a complaint about fly tipping.</p> <p>Cllr Sames confirmed that CDC are currently reviewing their Local Plan and both CDC and OCC have made budget changes to reflect the effect of COVID-19.</p>

Cllr Terzino stated that he had put back the barrier at the base of the gate between the sports field and Widnell Park because some people were not closing the gate from the Park out on to the road</p>		
48.	<p><b>Trees in the churchyard</b></p> <p>The Chair agreed to discuss potential work with the contractor.</p>		
49.	<p><b>Planning</b></p> <p><u><a href="#">20/01747/</a></u> Land South Side of Widnell Lane Piddington  <u><a href="#">F</a></u>  <u><a href="#">20/01122/F</a></u> Land north east of Bullingdon Prison.</p> <p>The clerk was asked to approach CDC planning for information as to when these applications would be considered by the Council and for an indication of the officer's recommendation.</p>
