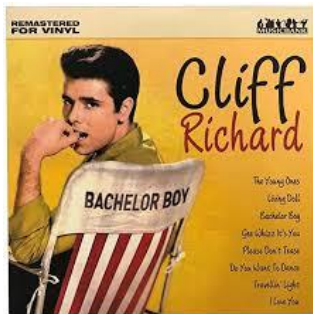


# Sat Night @Home – Karen & Derek Joy

**K:** My brother and I had a den in the cellar of our house. Our first taste of Freedom!!!



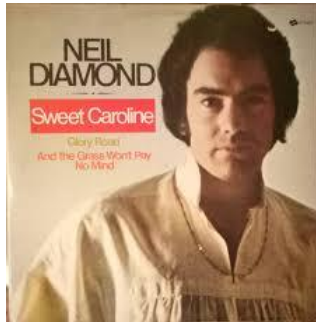
## 5: The Supremes – Stop! In the Name of Love (1965)

**K:** I remember doing a Go Go dance to this track with a friend on the stage at some do. Yikes!



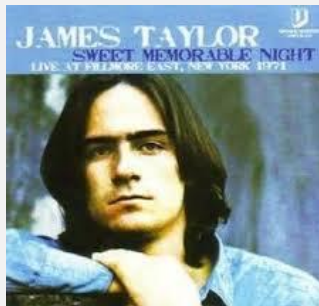
**6: Cast of Hair – Good Morning Starshine (1960)**

**K: I had a very ‘different’ grandma who took me to see Hair at the crazy age of 12 or thereabouts ...**



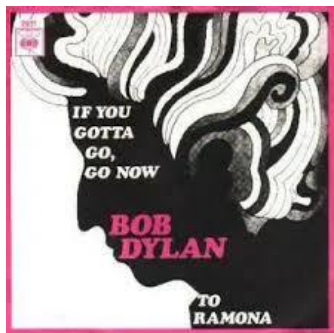
**7: Neil Diamond – Sweet Caroline (1969)**

**K: Travelling to Motor Cross with a lifelong mate.**



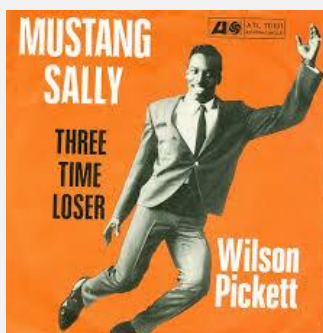
**8: James Taylor – Steam Roller Blues (1970)**

**K: Again, in my digs at college with a Chinese takeaway in front of my super serv!!!**



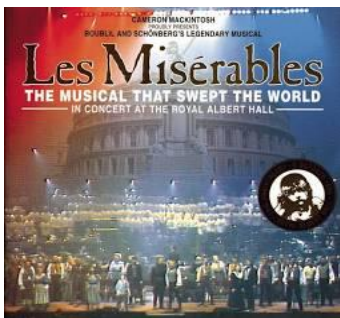
**13: Van Morrison – Tupelo Honey (1971)**

**D: I went to see this musical with my late wife countless times. Great song.**



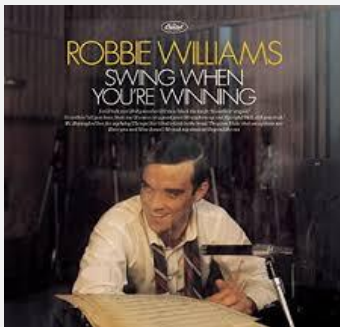
**16: Michael Ball – Love Changes Everything (1992)**
